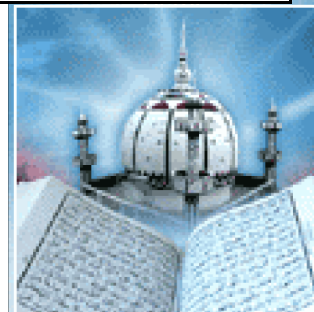
EDUCATION NEWS — Said Modak

Also anyone wishing to give NIYAAZ should contact any education committee member (numbers at the back)

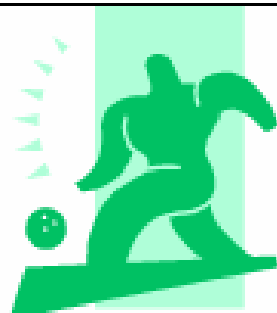
Finally at maktab we are studying Islamic Studies from the books of Abu Ameenah Bilal Phillips.
